



Out of Zone Enrolment Procedures

For some time now an enrolment zone has been placed around the school to ensure that neighbourhood students can access facilities and curriculum in appropriate and comfortable circumstances and that there is a reasonable distribution of students in adjacent school sites.

The limit for classes will be set according to the department's average maximum for each year level. This is 26 for R2 and 30 for Years 3-7.

Guidelines for enrolment

Parents residing outside of the zone wishing to enrol their children at Salisbury Heights Primary School can complete an enrolment form at the school after discussion with the principal. This enrolment form will be considered as an application for enrolment and placed on a waiting list.

The principal will consider the application for enrolment and in relation to vacancies, which may occur from time to time, according to class and school ceiling limits.

Where more than one application is lodged for similar vacancies a waiting list will be established according to the following criteria in priority order

1. distance as the crow flies from the school
2. curriculum needs
3. other eg medical, legal,

Enrolment of siblings from out of the zone is not automatic and is subject to the same criteria.

Unless a vacancy arises during the year, families will be informed in Term 4 if their application has been successful for the following year.
